Fellows will rotate through rural fire and EMS agencies situated along the Oregon Coast.

Exposure to air medical transport will be in conjunction with Life Flight Network.

Spend time in the Oregon wilderness areas while learning austere medicine techniques from OHSU Wilderness Medicine faculty.

Assist with regional on-line medical direction (OLMD) is based at the OHSU Medical Resource Hospital (MRH).

Receive training in research theory and techniques.

## Program Background

The Oregon Health and Science University (OHSU) Department of Emergency Medicine and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) faculty have supported an EMS Fellowship since 2000 and received ACGME accreditation in 2023.

The fellowship supports one fellow annually. Applications are accepted throughout the year with interviews occurring in late Summer through early Fall.

Our EMS Fellowship utilizes the National Resident Matching Program for final candidate selection.

## Mission

The OHSU EMS Fellowship in Emergency Medical Services aims to develop future leaders in prehospital medicine who will provide high-quality medical oversight and continue to advance out-of-hospital care.

## Application process

Applicants should have completed an Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) Emergency Medicine residency program. Applications are currently being accepted for 2024-2025.
