Resources for Rural Health Clinics (continued)

 - NARHC promotes RHCs as a means of improving and sustaining the availability of quality, cost-effective health care to patients in rural, medically underserved areas. NARHC works with Congress, federal agencies, and rural health allies to expand and protect the interests of rural health clinics.
- Conditions for Certification, 42 eCFR 491 Subpart A RHC
 - Regulations for the initial certification and re-certification survey
- RHC Services, 42 eCFR Part 405 Subpart X
- State Operations Manual Appendix G Guidance for Surveyors
- RHC Medicare Benefit Policy Manual Chapter 13 RHC Services
 - Refines RHCs, their services, and providers
- RHC Medicare Claims Processing Manual Chapter 9
 - Covers the difference between RHCs and FQHCs, Medicare payments, cost reports, lab services, agreements between CMS and RHCs, and termination of agreements.
