- Underlying diagnosis: **Systemic sclerosis w pulm HTN**

# Case #15: 26 y/o woman w TIA

- ED visit #1:
  - 5 minutes of right-sided weakness and dysarthria
    - Exam documented as normal
    - Discharged with PCP follow-up

# Case #15: 26 y/o woman w TIA

- ED visit #2:
  - Acute right-sided flank pain
    - "Subtle murmur" documented in the exam section
    - CT abdomen obtained out of concern for appendicitis

# Case #15: 26 y/o woman w TIA

OUT CT ABDOMEN/PELVIS W CONTRAST

- Admission (day #3)

    - Extensive workup for thrombophilia obtained
    - CTA chest obtained out of concern for pulmonary embolism


