

## How to Use the Oregon Rural Health Resource Hub


The Oregon Office of Rural Health (ORH) has created a new tool for our rural partners and communities called the [Oregon Rural Health Resource Hub](#) (the Hub).

The Hub functions as a place where both ORH and community partners can submit resources for others to access. Resources include funding opportunities, events, education, research, articles and publications, among other types.

These resources are aimed toward organizations such as rural hospitals, clinics, public health, community-based organizations and others to improve rural health at the community-level.

### Accessing the Hub

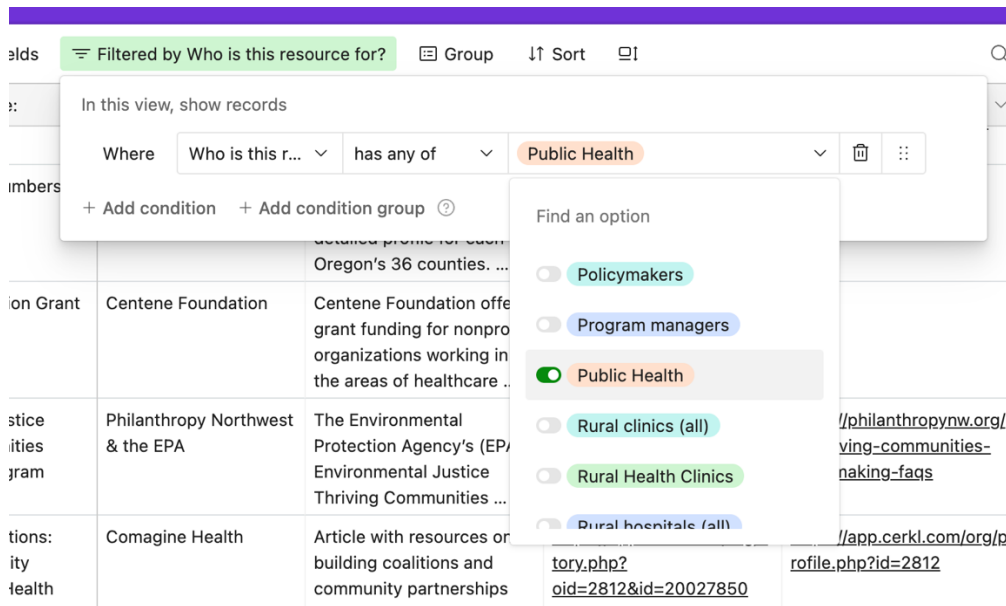

There are several ways to find the kinds of resources you are looking for in the Hub.

On the left-hand side, you can see the “Full Resource Hub List” under “Views.” This is the full list of resources that have been submitted to the Hub. You can go through this list or filter based on what you’re looking for.

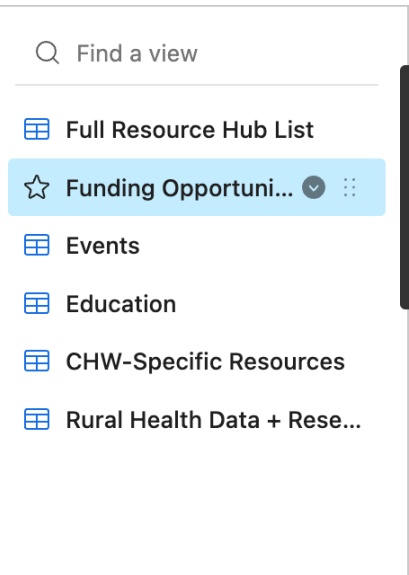
## How to filter:

- Click on the “filter” button on the ribbon at the top of the table.
- Next, you can filter by any of the tags in any of the columns.
- Let’s say you want to find resources that are applicable to public health departments. Click on the first box and select “Who is this resource for?” and then select “has any of” and then you can select “Public Health.” It will then filter the table to show all the resources that apply to public health.



- There are many tags you can search. Some of the categories you can search are:
  - Eligible counties
    - Select counties or search “statewide”
  - Resource type (see some of the tags below that you can search by)
    - Data/research
    - Education
    - Event
    - Funding
    - Technical assistance
    - Tool
    - Supplies
  - Who is this resource for? (see some of the tags below that you can search by)
    - C-suite
    - Clinicians
    - Hospitals
    - Clinics
    - EMS
    - Public health
    - CHWs

Additionally, ORH has created some pre-filtered “views” where you can see specific resources in a certain category. You can select these views on the left-hand side of the screen:



These views filter items from the main list (i.e., the Full Resource Hub List) and just show select entries related to the view title. There is a view for funding opportunities, events, education, CHW-specific resources and rural health data + resources.

Anyone can submit resources to the Hub! ORH encourages partners to submit resources to make this a living resource for our state.
