## Safe driving in Oregon: winter weather preparation tips from ODOT

Have your vehicle checked – especially the battery, tires, antifreeze, wipers and windshield washer fluid, ignition system, thermostat, lights, exhaust system, heater, brakes and defroster.

Install winter tires or have traction devices and know how to install them.

Fill up your gas tank when you know a storm is coming.

Have deicer on hand for vehicle door locks.

Put together a survival kit with an ice scraper, jumper cables, shovel, pliers and screwdrivers, blankets, extra clothes, boots, gloves and hats, a small sack of sand to use for traction, flares, a flashlight, a tarp, non-perishable food, bottled water and a first aid kit. Keep it in your vehicle.
